CABIN AIR FILTER - INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Est. Installation Time: less than 15 min.

The Cabin Air Filter is located behind the glove box.

- Using a philips screwdriver, remove the 2 screws at the bottom of the bottom of the glove box
- 2. Open the glove compartment and remove the 4 screws across the top of the glove compartment (2 in the center are securing the latch) Fig. 1
- Slowly pull out the glove box assembly.
 Hold once you see the wires and light module




WARNING: DO NOT LET THE GLOVE COMPARTMENT HANG BY THE AIR BAG MODULE WIRES. DO NOT PULL ON THE AIR BAG MODULE WIRES. DO NOT DISCONNECT THE AIR BAG MODULE WIRES.

- 4. Unclip the airbag sensor form the box assembly utilizing a plier Fig. 2. Detach the light modular.
- 5. Remove the glove compartment assembly from the dashboard and set aside.



- Locate the filter housing cover.
 Using a flat screwdriver, unclip the metal clip at the lower side of the cover
- 7. Slid the cover up to disengage it and remove it
- 8. Pull out the two old filters and clean the housing
- Insert the first new filter with the "X" plastic shape facing the driver side. Slid the first filter up and insert the second new filter
- 10. Close the housing cover, slide it down and secure it with the metal clip.
- 11. Connect the light wires. Snap back the airbag sensor module.
- 12. Follow the reverse steps to install the glove box assembly and secure it with the 6 screws
