
CABIN AIR FILTER – INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

The Cabin air filter is located under the dashboard on the passenger side


- 1. Locate the filter housing cover
- 2. Push and slid the cover to the right to remove it
- 3. Pull the old filter down
- Push the new filter up into the housing. It will fit in only one orientation – See ==>
- 5. Reinstall the housing cover, by hooking it in the receiving slots and slide it to the left

Some application requires the following procedure

- 1. Remove bolts -A- if necessary. See →
- 2. Bolt -A- is not installed on all vehicles. Bolts secure the cover -B- in the event the catches -D- no longer hold.
- 3. Push cover -B- in direction of -arrow C- and remove cover
- 4. Screw clips -A- are available in different versions. For example, -C- and -D-. See →
- 5. Remove filter element -A- from shaft -B- of air conditioner or heater.
- 6. Clean the surrounding area of the dust and pollen filter in air conditioner shaft or heating before installing a new filter. Using a vacuum cleaner, clean shaft -B- of A/C unit or heater. Install in reverse order of removal.
