

CABIN AIR FILTER – INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Part No.: **PC5872HX** Est. Installation Time: **less than 15 min**

Subaru- Baja (03-06), Legacy (00-04), Outback (00-04)

The Cabin air filter is located on the passenger side of the vehicle behind the glove box

- Push in on both sides of the glove box while pulling down to clear the two knock pins on each side
- Let the glove box swing all the way downward
- Locate and remove the glove box installation screws, one on each side and up to three across the top
- Remove the center console's lower right panel by removing screws and pulling it out
- Disconnect the glove box light harness
- Remove the two knock pins to facilitate reinstallation later
- Remove the four clips that secure the filter housing cover in place
- Remove the cabin filter housing cover
- Remove the lower filter first by grabbing its handle. Remove top filter by pulling it down, then out
- Install the new filters making sure that the air flow directional arrow is pointing up
- Reinstall in reverse order
